### **AGREEMENT WITH AIRBUS FOR PURCHASE OF A350 AIRCRAFT CANCELLED**

Milan, 28 January 2008 – Eurofly and Airbus decided to cancel the agreement signed on 30 December 2005 for the purchase of three A350 long-haul aircraft.

Airbus's decision to start researching a new version of this aircraft (A350-XWB), with more advanced technology, led to a 24-month delay in delivery times, with respect to the 2013 and 2014 due dates originally scheduled for Eurofly. In view of this, Eurofly decided not to convert the order for the A350s into the new A350-XWBs. In the light of this decision, the two parties reached a confidential agreement that will not have a negative effect on Eurofly's profit and loss account, or give rise to additional financial requirements.

However, Eurofly continues to operate a fleet consisting entirely of Airbus, with eight A320s (medium-range) and of five A330-200s (long-range aircraft). Eurofly and Airbus continue to work together on the future development of Eurofly's fleet.
