Strike of flight assistants

Milan, 6 July 2006- Eurofly informs that the 24 hours strike of the flight assistants members of the Trade Unions FILT-CIGL and FIT-CISL CV that took place yesterday, Wednesday 5th July, had a 2,13% adhesion. The strike had no impact on company's operations, which took place regularly without cancellations or delays. Granted time range and minimum essential services were respected, as settled in the Temporary Regulation of the 01/92 resolution of 19th July 2001.

Flights from Malpensa (Mi), Linate (MI) and Oro al Serio (BG) airport from 00.01 to 23.59 were involved by the strike. The motivations of the strike were linked presumed contractual violations regarding the utilization of the labour force and the request of different configuration of the rest accommodations reserved to the flight assistants. Eurofly considers the argument without reason, but is available for a dialogue, which already started during the last weeks, in order to find a common solution.
